



Science

- The first step in science is naming things. Animals, plants, parts of animals and plants, rocks, stars, cells, atoms, parts of atoms etc. We analyse and measure nature.
- The second step is understanding how the different parts of the world and universe work together. We formulate scientific laws.
- The third step is using this knowledge to enable us to control the world around us, make new materials, medicines, tools, machines etc.



● Poetry, singing and music

Much of the Bible is poetry. Hebrew poetry depended on *rhythm* not *rhyme* and it would sometimes be sung. Musical instruments were used to accompany singing, to celebrate, to mourn and to bring encouragement and comfort (1 Samuel 16:14-23, 2 Kings 3:14-19).
