





Although we are commanded to love everybody, we are not commanded to trust everybody. Some people who we love dearly we may never be able to trust. In fact</p>	<p>the Bible warns us against trusting in people too much because we will be disappointed (Jer 17:5, Ps 146:3-4). Jesus loved everybody he met but he did not always trust them (John 2:23-25).</p> <p>We need to seek to become trustworthy people. Trust can be earned through our love, honesty and reliability. Good two-way human relationships need a high degree of trust in order to operate effectively.</p> <p>God is 100% loving, honest, reliable and trustworthy and we are encouraged many times in the Bible to put our trust in him (Ps 118:8, Ps 125:1, Prov 3:5).</p>
