




What is happening in these pictures - Which season is each picture?

Do you know anywhere in the world where it is always summer?


What was the weather like in Narnia?




Monday - Through the wardrobe (2)


Thursday - The stone table

Jesus carried his cross through Jerusalem before the soldiers put him on it.



He heard the angels singing, and this is what they sang:




